

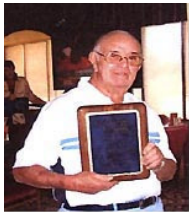


Painted Mountain Men's Golf Club

WHEN: Saturday, January 28, 2012 – Painted Mountain Golf Resort – 8AM Shotgun Start

FORMAT: 4-player Scramble. This is a Member/Guest tournament – and open to the General Golfing Public. Please invite your spouses and friends to play. Men will utilize the White Tees; Women & Juniors will utilize the Red Tees. This tournament will not be handicapped.



HONOREE: Bob Staelens - An Air Force veteran, Bob and his wife Shirley began playing golf at Painted Mountain, then called Camelot in 1969. Bob became the head of guest services at Painted Mountain and was for many years its finest ambassador of golf. He was a past president of the Men's Club, and held every Club office at one time or another, until a few months before his death in 2010. The Painted Mountain Men's Golf Club is proud to honor the memory of Bob Staelens by hosting this golf tournament.

SPECIAL CONTESTS:

- Closest-To-Pin off the tee on all other Par-3s (#2, #10, #12, #15, and #16)
- Putting Contest. We will have a full 9-hole "course" set up on the putting green, including hazards, to be played immediately following the scramble. Always a popular event.
- Tournament-wide Drawing for Cash and Prizes
- Magic Putts granted if you enter all 4 of the above contests.
- *All contest details will be available on the day of play.*

PRIZES: Winners names will be inscribed on the Bob Staelens Cup located at the Painted Mountain pro shop. Winners of Special Contests and selected places will also receive prizes in a presentation to follow the golf.

ENTRY FEE: \$57 includes golf, cart, an All-American Buffet (hamburgers, hot dogs, baked beans, fries, cole slaw, soda, and ice tea), tax & tip. A portion of each entry fee will go to WWP. Each Special Contest described above has an additional \$5 entry fee, all of which goes to WWP (except what is paid out in the Cash Drawing).
